## TABLETOP

Wide choice of HPL colours for the tabletop.

**Tabletop type** Laminated chipboard.

**Tabletop thickness** 20 mm.

**Tabletop construction** Top side in HPL. Core in chipboard with white cover underneath.. Matching edges in rounded ABS.

**Corners** 4 rounded corners, radius 40 mm.

## TABLE LEGS



Curved leg in laminated beech, stained (in a choice of colours) and varnished. Cross-section 60x30 mm, square corners. PE floor glides on the bottom.






## TABLE CONSTRUCTION

### BASIC



The 4 legs are glued and fixed with 4 (invisible) screws to the tabletop. The legs are angled at the corners, leaving optimal space between the two legs. The angled shape of the leg makes the tabletop appear to float.
